### MISSION STATEMENT

Interests 8. Informed choices). So that they may prepare for & engage in gainful employment, vocational training &/or self-employment.



**PROGRAM GOAL:** To improve employment outcomes for American Indians with disabilities by providing effective vocational rehabilitation services, by developing an IPE Individual Plan for Employment to reach a successful employment goal.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Current documentation of Disability.
- 2) CIB of Federally recognized tribe or Tribal ID.
- 3) Impediments or impairments (barriers) to maintain employment.
- 4) Consumer must live on or within the 65 mile service radius.
- 5) Consumer must have a reasonable expectation for VR to help
- 6) TVR is an alcohol & drug free program
