Youth Transition Program Eligibility:

- A. Tribal ID of Federally Recognized Tribe
- B. TVR application
- C. Most recent IEP or
- D. Documented Disability (medical, Mental or Physical)
- E. Parental Consent if a minor
- F. TVR is an alcohol & drug free program
